

Problems To Watch For After Your Out-patient Blood Transfusion



During the first 24 hours:

Sometimes problems can come up during the first 24 hours after your blood transfusion.

Call (214) 266-8777 if you have any of the problems listed below, and they are not a usual part of your illness:

- Nausea (feeling sick to your stomach)
- Vomiting
- Trouble breathing
- Skin rash
- Blood in your urine (pee)

During the next few months:

Sometimes, some of the problems can come up several months after your transfusion.

Call (214) 266-8777 if you have any of the problems listed below:

- Fever
- Dark colored urine (pee)
- Jaundice (yellow color to your eyes or skin)
